Acceptance of Minutes: Janis moved to accept the minutes. Maureen seconded.

Treasurer's Report:

- Balance Sheet is currently over \$90,000 in cash
- Janis provided an overview of the comparison performed of revenue and expenses from last year and what activities took place in October
- Noteworthy is the generous donation received of \$3,000 from Jackie Stone and how impactful this donation is
- Almost all vendors and libraries have paid their bills and there is not much in the way of outstanding invoices
- YTD for raffle sales came in around \$3,600
- Blind Date with a Book continues to generate good money. As of November 1^{st,} there were over 44 books sold, book donation drive to take place on the 15th to restock inventory
- The improv comedy show has taken in over \$1,500 thus far, final numbers will be provided at next month's meeting

Acceptance of the Treasurer's Report: Dorit made a motion to approve. Joanne seconded.

Director's Report:

- The library staff have provided their funding requests for programming, the amounts are roughly the same and very reasonable coming in under the determined allotted amount.
- Stats for the library will be provided quarterly; included in that there were around 26,800 attendees for programs and events
- The TPL will be closed 11/11, 11/27 & 28 for November Holidays. There will be a late opening at 11:00 AM on 11/20 and early closure at 3:30PM on 11/26.
