Acceptance of Minutes: Joann Toppin moved to accept the minutes. Doret Pool seconded.

Treasurer's Report:

- Currently, the Friends have about \$42,000 available for immediate use.
- There is another \$31,000 in a Town Account that requires a request and permission to use.
- Gross Revenue for 2025 is about \$200 more than 2024 YTD.
- Total spending year to date for programs 2024 was \$40,472 and for 2025, \$39,020.
- Special Fundraising year to date is down by about \$100 from 2024.
- Nancy Cohen made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. Doret Pool seconded.

Director's Report:

- The summer was busy, with 21,617 visitors.
- 36.910 items were checked out over the summer.
- The Teen Department doubled the school supply drive from 2024, and 120 students and families benefitted in the first 15 minutes of distribution.
- There is a whimsical Stick Library available for your 4-legged friends. It is dedicated to the library's reading dogs.
- September is Library Card Month. Use your library card at town businesses to receive discounts. More information is available on the website.
- MassHire van visits the library once a week (Wednesday mornings) to provide job seeking assistance.
- VinFen comes once a week to help with housing needs.
- Tech help is available by appointment at the library.

Trustee Report:

- Bonnie Page was in attendance to provide a trustee report.
- Trustees met and freshened up assorted library policies.
